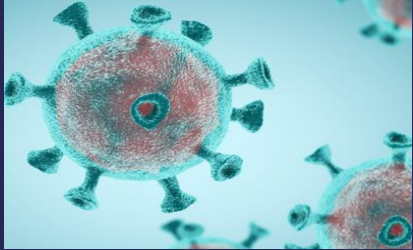


Cutaneous manifestations of Covid disease and vaccines for its prevention: A review of the existing literature
